In 1850 Dr William Penny Brookes instigated an annual Wenlock Olympian Games for the people of Wenlock and the surrounding area. The founder of the modern Olympic Games, Pierre de Coubertin visited Much Wenlock in 1890 and was inspired to use the principles behind this event to start the Modern Olympics. The Wenlock Olympian Society's significant role in the revival of the modern Olympian Movement was acknowledged at the London 2012 Olympics, including the naming of the mascot for the Games as "Wenlock".

We would like to welcome back everyone to the this games due to be held on Sunday, 26 September 2021. We would like to particularly invite young local fencers in both Foil and Epee. Places will be limited due to the venue restrictions and may be varied by the organisers in light of changes to Covid advice, so please apply early. Currently only officials will be allowed in the sports hall but there will be plenty of open air events taking place on the site and fencers will be welcome to meet parents in the open air and we hope to have a tent available for this.

Format: Within age groups to be agreed depending on the number of entries, the aim would be to maximise the participants fencing.
